

RLA Meeting Minutes 5/15/2021

Annual General Meeting:

The RLA held its annual meeting at Crescent Beach on May 15th. The discussion included:

Permits: A staff shortage at DEEP is contributing to our treatment company being unable to secure permits for lake treatments. Hopefully the hold up will be short lived.

Dam: We are also waiting for DEEP to review our engineer's report on the condition of the dam. The inspection was done last year and is required every seven years.

Dredging: Attempts to reuse the existing bag are still in the works.

Dredging at Crescent Beach is on schedule for this fall.

Wataba Fest: The Festival is not an RLA event though the RLA is a vendor and thus able to raise money at the event.

Dues: While dues were raised modestly this year for the first time in several years, the increase did not take place until after April 1st.

Membership: Perhaps due to the delayed increase membership was up in the early spring. Marc reports 128 members thus far.

Budget: Mike presented a proposed budget of \$31,945 for 2021, a slight increase over 2020. The budget was approved by unanimous vote of those present.

Elections: Three candidates had announced their intentions to run for one of three open board positions, making the election moot. Jeff and Chris will remain on the board and will be joined by newcomer Alan Hanley. Welcome Alan!
